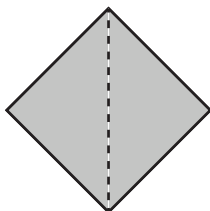


How to make an origami star

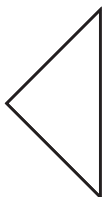
You will need:

two sheets of square paper
An adhesive (tape, glue or sticky tack)

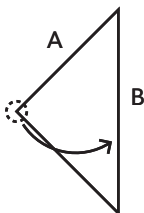
- ① Start with one piece of paper, colour side up, rotated 45 degrees into a diamond shape. Fold the paper from right to left along the dotted line.



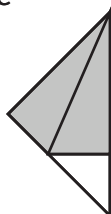
You should have something that looks like this.



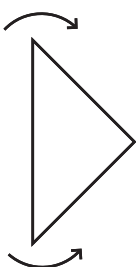
- ② Fold the circled point back over to the vertical right edge, so edge A aligns with edge B and the coloured side is revealed.



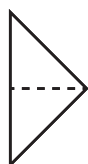
You should have something that looks like this.



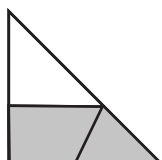
- ③ Turn the paper over so the flat, non-coloured side is visible and the triangle is pointing towards the right.



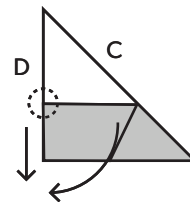
- ④ Fold the paper in half along the crease, so that the bottom point touches the top.



You should have something that looks like this.

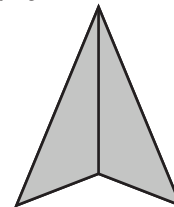


- ⑤ Take the circled point, pull it downwards and flatten, so edge C aligns vertically with edge D.

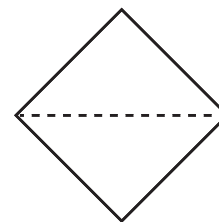


You should now have a shape like this.

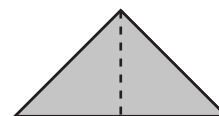
Leave to one side



- ⑥ Take your second sheet of paper, non-coloured side up, and fold it across the dotted line.



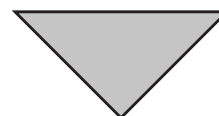
- ⑦ Fold in half again along the dotted line, so the right point touches the left.



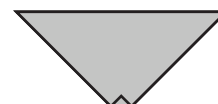
You should have something that looks like this.



- ⑧ Rotate so the longest edge is horizontal along the top.



Fold the bottom point upwards slightly.



- ⑨ Place this piece of paper in-between the two flaps of the first piece of paper like so. Align so the shapes are symmetrical and attach with tape, glue or sticky tack.
